GENERAL INFORMATION**

SCOPE: An individual scholarship of \$500.00 each will be awarded to one eligible graduating senior. The purpose of the scholarships is to reward academic excellence in connection with school and community involvement.

TERMS: Scholarships are \$500.00 (non-renewable) to be utilized for tuition and lab fees. Scholarship checks will be sent directly to the award winner's high school to be forwarded on to the college or university.
Any unused funds will be forfeited by the student and returned to THK.

Applications for scholarships must be made to the high school principal/counselor by the appointed time. The principal/counselor and designated committee will be responsible for the selection of the scholarship recipient according to the criteria listed below. The school will inform THK of the name of the scholarship winner and necessary information by the required due date.

CRITERIA: Scholarship applicants must meet all of the following criteria in order to be eligible for consideration of scholarship funds:

- Be a senior in good standing and eligible for graduation
- Possess an overall high GPA of 3.3 or better
- Be accepted at an accredited two or four year university/college
- Attend a college or university on full-time basis
- Additional consideration to be given to a son/daughter of a current THK Employee.
